Yurara Youth Art Awards – Mentorship Program

Five years ago, Yurara included a free six-month mentorship program with the Youth Art Awards for any student who participated in the awards.

The idea being that the young artists would benefit from (mainly Sunday) sessions by professional artists/tutors in our friendly art society's studio environment. Each student's capabilities are assessed for areas that would require extra stimulation to promote positive development.

Most of the tuition is given by Robin Wilson, a professional artist and Yurara tutor for some years who holds a current 'blue card'.

Any medium is used. Drawing, pencils, charcoal, pastels, inks, pen and wash, watercolours, acrylics, oil.

Although the mentorship is for six months, due to school work over the weekends and other activities during the year, it can be lengthened over that year period suiting the availability of the student.

Tutoring times are 11am-4pm on Sundays and all that is needed is 'bring your own lunch'.

Each student participating in the awards has automatic free membership at Yurara for one year until the following year's awards and if they choose to continue it remains the same until the completion of Year 12. Emerging artists from 18-21 pay a yearly membership fee of \$20 until full membership.

All membership entitles students to participate in the monthly rotating exhibitions which gives them experience in a gallery, relevant workshops, and free group sessions during the holidays.
